

Mark Price is the CEO of local charity Provision House, which is based in the former Co-op building at the top of Dudley High Street. Mark has overseen the rapid expansion of the charity since its move to Dudley in January 2019, which now employs 21 staff and 30+ volunteers.

As a resident of Dudley from birth, Mark is passionate about bringing new life to Dudley through regeneration and reimagination of the town through supporting the locals who live here.

Provision House works with people through 3 pillars of Rehabilitation, Stabilisation, and Progression, essentially supporting people from crisis to self sufficiency with a range of projects from providing furniture packages, food support, training, counselling, work placements, budgeting support and lots more.

The building houses a number of tenant organisations who are supporting locals in a variety of ways, and its location in the heart of the St Thomas Quarter of Dudley town gives a unique perspective of the needs and opportunities that Dudley has.

Mark has worked for Provision House (which was formerly known as Loaves n Fishes) since late 2017, having previously been a primary school teacher, Assistant Head Teacher, and Acting Head Teacher at local schools.
