3. Headlines from the Budget / Update on Long Term Plan for Towns	EA presented a summary of the email confirming LTPfT is to be repackaged and continue and other budget headlines.  Board agreed announcement was positive and reaffirmed their commitment to public engagement and grassroots activity, and their role in facilitating this.  Questions regarding UKSPF funding – values, contracts and programme continuation. Noted continuation funding announced but at a reduced level, further information to follow as detail not yet known.		

4. Towns Fund overview and monitoring return	Adam Westwood attended for this item and presented an overview of the Towns Fund project and the current draft monitoring return.  The Board raised and discussed questions relating to finances, outputs and availability of placements for students.  In relation to the monitoring return there was discussion about the operating costs which were confirmed as being the College's responsibility and outside the monitoring return. Request to better understand these at a future opportunity.  Board supported the Chair signing the monitoring return.		
5. Urban Rooms presentation	Lorna Prescott attended for this item and provided a background to her work and the current Urban Rooms collective learning enquiry.  The relationship with the community engagement focus of LTPfT was noted and the Chair encouraged board members to promote and support the Urban Room project.
